This section is for phone safety.

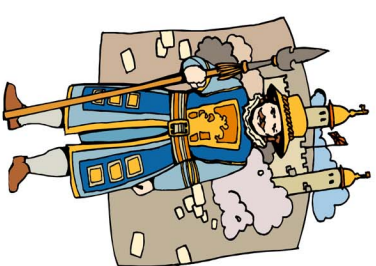
If your child is old enough to be answering the phone, this will provide some opportunities to talk about your household rules about the phone. Talk with your child in a open and honest way. The point isn't to scare them but to equip them with the skills to recognize and respond to potentially dangerous situations.

Some things to talk about:

- Never tell anyone you're alone
- Never tell anyone you're address (unless you called emergency)

Let them know what's expected of them....can they pick up the phone if your in the bathroom? What about when your at the store? Be clear about your rules.
